


























Las Vegas MSA Employment








Unemployment Rate Not Seasonally Adjusted











Employment DistributionSouthern Nevada Workers






Nevada Household Income Distributions









Clark County Hispanic Density Top 10 Zip Codes






Valley-Wide Neighborhood Risk Index


TANF| Valley-wide Distribution Map


SNAP | Valley-wide Distribution Map


Medicaid Valley-wide Distribution Map


Unemp. Insurance | Valley-wide Distribution Map

Foreclosures | Valley-wide Distribution Map



Residential Vacancy | Valley-wide Distribution Map



Bank Owned Homes | Valley-wide Distribution Map




Composite Risk | Valley-wide Distribution Map
















SAT Mean Scores of College-Bound Seniors | Critical Reading







